VERSE 1:



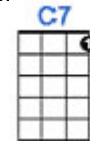
Blue moon, you saw me standing alone.



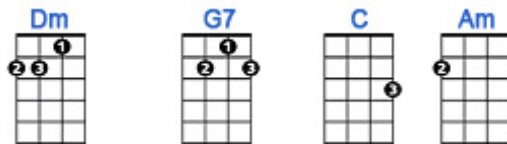
Without a dream in my heart, without a love of my own.

VERSE 2:

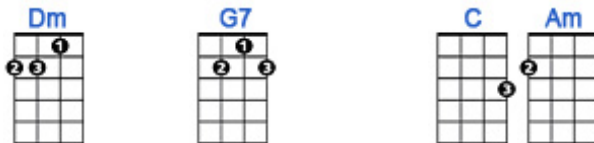
Blue moon, You knew just what I was there for.
You heard me saying a prayer for someone I really could care for.



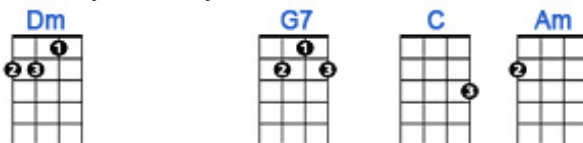
