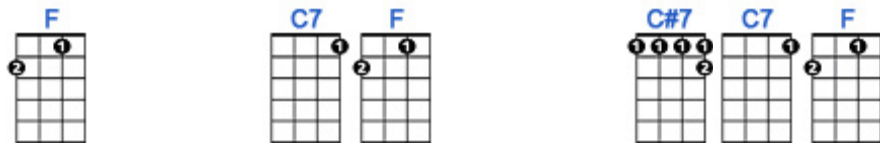

There something tender in the moonlight On Hono lu lu Bay

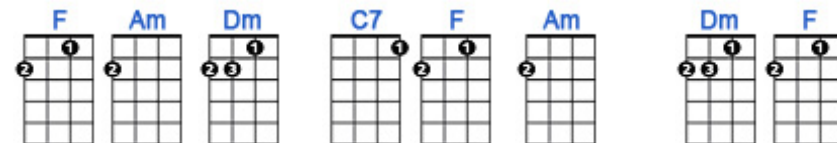


And all the beaches are full of peaches who bring their 'ukes' along

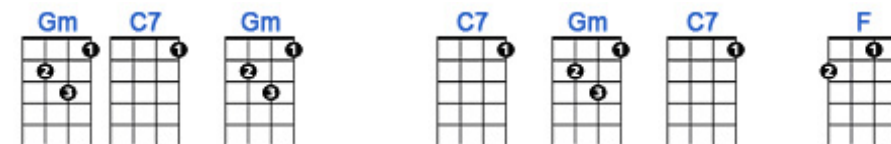


And in the glimmer of the moonlight, they love to sing this song
