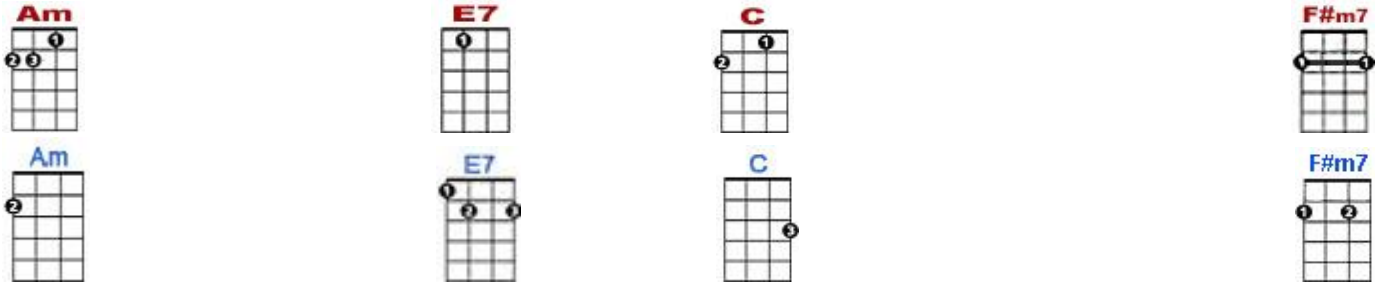
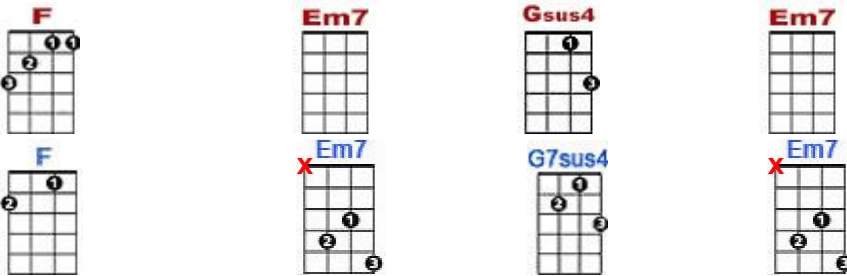


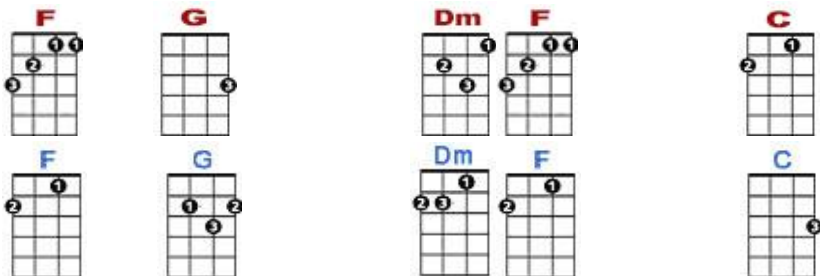
A Song For You by Leon Russell

I've acted out my love in stages, with ten thousand people watching.

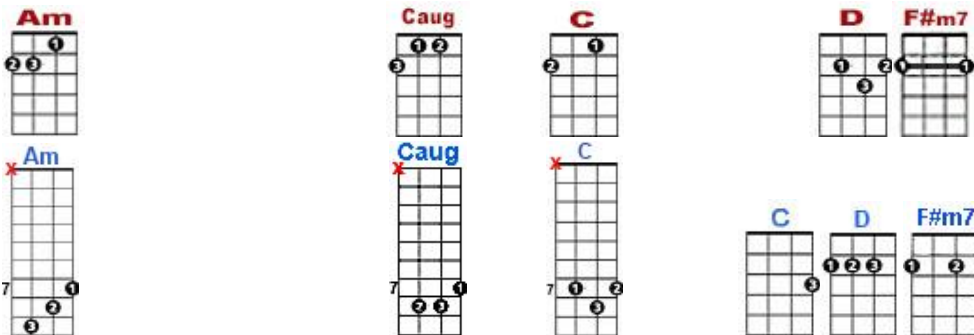


But we're a-lone now and I'm sing - ing this song to you.

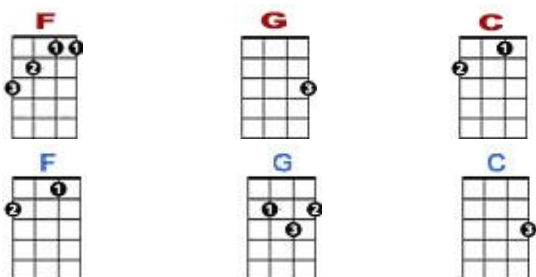
2nd VERSE:

 'cause we're alone now and I'm sing-ing this song to you.

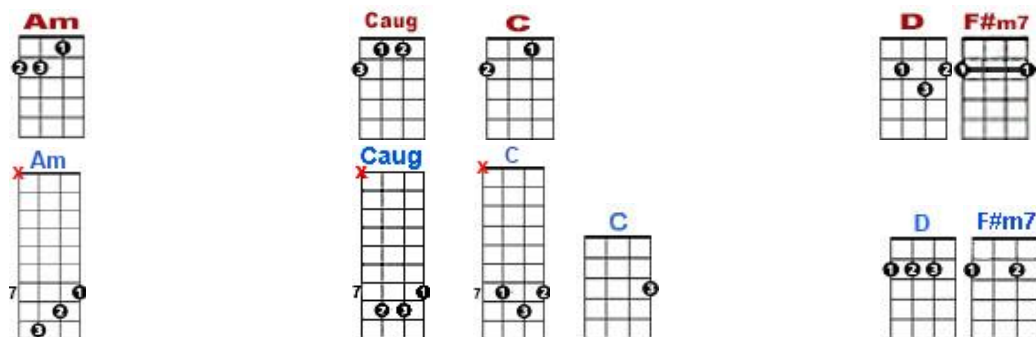
BRIDGE:



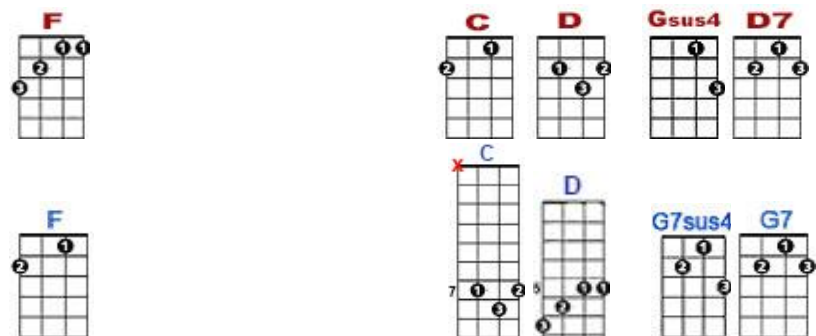
You taught me precious se-crets of the truth withhol-ding noth-thing.
